EXPLANATION OF TERMS

ACCESS LINES

A circuit between the station protector on the customer's telephone service or PBX to, and including, the serving central office main frame.

ACCESSORIES

Devices which are mechanically attached to, or used with, the facilities furnished by the Company and which are independent of, and not electrically, acoustically or inductively connected to the communications path of the telecommunications systems.

ACCOUNT RETENTION

Allows a customer to retain their current phone number and associated services when they temporarily disconnect service. When the customer reconnects service they will receive the same phone number and associated services as when they previously held service.

ACOUSTIC CONNECTION

A connection made by sound.

AIRLINE MEASUREMENT

See MILEAGE AND ZONE CHARGES

ALTERNATING CURRENT SUPPLY

Electrical energy which is used for power purposes, for protection of equipment in humid areas, and for the operation of bells and signal devices.

APPOINTMENT CALL

See LONG DISTANCE MESSAGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE.

AUTHORIZED PROTECTIVE CONNECTING MODULE

A protective unit which is designed and manufactured in compliance with standards as set forth by Part 68 of the FCC Rules and Regulations.

AUTHORIZED USER

A person, firm, or corporation, other than the subscriber, who has been authorized by the Company to communicate over a private line or channel according to the terms of the tariff and (1) on whose premises a station of the private line service is located or (2) who receives from or sends to the subscriber over such private line or channel communications relating solely to the business of the subscriber.

EXPLANATION OF TERMS

SUPPLEMENTAL CONTRACT

A contract for service, equipment, or facilities in addition to that provided for under the original contract.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE

The services offered by the Company accessing the exchange switching network, including, but not limited to those services covered by the General Exchange, Local Exchange, Message Toll, Wide Area Telephone Service, and Mobile Telephone Service Tariffs.

TELEPHONE ANSWERING SWITCHBOARD

An arrangement of jacks for terminating subscriber lines, either as a primary line or an extension of a primary line, for answering purposes only. Answering is accomplished by use of cord circuits equipped with cords, plugs, and keys.

TELEPHONE OR TELECOMMUNICATIONS NETWORK

The local telephone exchange and long distance message telecommunications facilities or network, both interstate and intrastate.

TELEPHONE NUMBER

A designation assigned to a main station, central office line, or private branch exchange station for convenience in placing calls and for identification in the assessment of message charges, etc. Such designation usually consists of a seven-digit number comprised of a three-digit central office code (name or numeral) followed by a four-digit station number.
