Introduction

This filing increases the rates for Auxiliary line. The basic rates were increased in AT&T Florida's 2005 and 2006 rebalancing tariff filings and these lines should have been increased at that time since the tariff clearly ties these lines to basic service. AT&T inadvertently omitted these increase in our rebalancing tariff filings and are trying to correct the oversight with this filing. There are only a few customers (approximately 30). The customers were notified in 2005 and 2006 of the increases and have been billed these rates since those times. The Auxiliary line is a service in the Non-Basic Business basket.

Service charges specified in Section A4. of this Tariff do not apply for transactions involving only additions, deletions or changes to the services/features requested as part of this service.

Note 1: The Multi-line Exchange Access Line rate applies per line to subscribers with more than one exchange access line.
