EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Introduction

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T – Florida is revising the Access Services Tariff to remove the DS3 Network Interface Unit (NIU) with Loop Back Capability from E13. This unit will be provisioned to customers as part of their Special Access (SPA) DS3 service at no additional charge.

Description of Existing Service

The DS3 NIU with Loop Back Capability is used by BellSouth to provide performance monitoring and event history information to aid in trouble isolation and maintenance of SPA DS3 services. The DS3 NIU with Loop Back Capability is provisioned at the customer premises as network channel terminating equipment (NCTE) that is part of BellSouth's network. The current tariff provides a nonrecurring charge of \$400 per DS3 NIU for initial SPA DS3 orders and \$475 per DS3 NIU for subsequent orders SPA DS3 service.

Description of Proposed Filing

This filing proposes to remove the DS3 NIU with Loop Back Capability from E13 and provide the unit at no additional charge to customers as part of new SPA DS3 service installations and on existing SPA DS3 services, as required, at no additional charge.

This filing will enable the DS3 NIU with Loop Back Capability to be provisioned consistent with other AT&T regional companies (i.e., as part of SPA DS3 service at no additional charge), which provides a single, standardized circuit design for all AT&T SPA DS3 services.

BellSouth SPA Managed Shared Ring Network). The DS3 Network Interface Unit (NIU) loop back function is accessible only by the customer of the DS3 service. For installation of such DS3 NIUs associated with existing services, an outage of the customer's service is required. This outage shall be as authorized by the customer and a credit for service outage will not be applicable.~~
