9.2.2 ABN Advantage Plan*

A. General

Customers subscribing to ABN Advantage Plan must also subscribe to ABN Advantage Plan Local service as describe in Section 7 of AT&T's Local Exchange Services tariff.

This service is a combined interstate/intrastate offering. See the AT&T Business Services Guide for a complete service description, explanation of service usage, and terms and conditions.

B. Monthly Minutes of Use (MOU) Caps

Long Distance usage above the specified MOU Cap is not included in the Monthly Recurring Charge, but will be billed at a per minute rate as specified in the RATE SCHEDULE. The following MOU Caps apply per account, depending on the access used:

Access Type	MOU Cap
DS-1/ISDN PRI	25,000 MOU per month
Trunk	1,250 MOU per month
Line	750 MOU per month
