2. GENERAL REGULATIONS

- 2.9 Violation of Regulations (Cont'd)
 - 2.9.3 Nonpayment of Charges

The Company may deny and/or restrict Custom Network Service for nonpayment of charges due as specified in section 2.5.3 (Payment of Charges) preceding. A written notice will be sent to the customer at least five days in advance of the restriction and/or denial of Custom Network Service. Upon payment of charges the restriction and/or denial of Custom Network Service will be removed.

2.10 Special Promotions

The Company may offer special promotions of new or existing services or products for limited periods with approval by the Commission. These promotional offerings, designed to attract new customers or to increase existing customer awareness of a particular offering, are subject to the availability of services and facilities and may be limited to a specific geographic area or to a subset of a specific market group.

- 2.11 Contract Service Arrangements
 - 2.11.1 General
 - A. When economically practicable, customer specific contract service arrangements may be furnished in lieu of existing tariff offerings.
 - 1. Rates, Charges, Terms and additional regulations, if applicable, for the contract service arrangements will be developed on an individual case basis.
 - 2. Unless otherwise specified, the regulations for contract service arrangements are in addition to the applicable regulations and rates specified in other sections of this Tariff.
- 2.12 Payphone Use Charge

In addition to all other charges for Customer Network Services under this tariff, a non-discountable Payphone Use Charge of \$.56 shall apply to each coinless call which AT&T can identify as placed from a domestic payphone by or to the Customer or its permitted users. This charge does not apply to calls completed using AT&T 800 Plan P Service or calls that are subject to the payphone charge specified in this Company's Florida General Services Tariff. This charge is for the use of the payphone instrument to access AT&T services.
