

- c. Costs for the contract service arrangements will include one or more of the following items:
 - 1. Labor, engineering, and materials
 - 2. Operating expenses, e.g., maintenance, administration, etc.
 - 3. Return on investment
 - 4. Taxes
 - 5. Depreciation
 - 6. Any other identifiable associated cost
- d. Unless otherwise specified, the regulations for contract service arrangements are in addition to the applicable regulations and rates specified in other Section of this Tariff.
- e. Contract Service Arrangements may be offered on any non-basic service, as defined in Chapter 364.02(10) of the Florida statutes, in this tariff that satisfies the requirements specified in this section of the tariff. Contract Service Arrangements may be offered for a basic service only if the basic service is offered as a part of a package with non-basic services.

C. CONTRACT SERVICE ARRANGEMENTS

1. General

Contract Srv Arrangements may be offered for a basic service only if the basic service is offered as a part of a package with non-basic services.
