This filing proposes to grandfather various toll blocking and screening options. Certain options which will remain available with PATS Lines, are being relocated to that section of the tariff for consistency with the PATS blocking and screening already appearing in that section. Answer Supervision, a service only available with PATS Lines, is also being relocated to that section for consistency and standardization. The availability of 976/900 blocking at no charge in Section A13.M.1. is not affected by this filing and continues to be available to all customers. None of these changes affect current customers.
