BY THE COMMISSION:

This docket was initiated pursuant to request filed by Cobban Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Marty's Mini-Mart Texaco (Cobban) to cancel its certificate of public convenience and necessity number 831, which allows for the provision of pay telephone service. Cobban no longer plans to offer pay telephone service.

We, therefore, approve Cobban's request to cancel its certificate of public convenience and necessity number 831 to provide pay telephone service and the same is hereby cancelled. If Cobban has not already done so, it is directed to return its certificate forthwith to the Commission.

Our cancellation of Cobban's certificate and the closing of this docket in no way diminishes its obligation to pay applicable delinquent regulatory assessment fees.
