- FPL has no objection to TPUG's request to take official notice of Order No. 18340 or any other Commission Order.
- Request to yet again modify its argument by suggesting that the allegations in its Petition regarding "FPL's use of the oil backout mechanism to avoid regulatory overview of ROE" is an appropriate consideration in whether or not to retain or terminate the Oil Backout Cost Recovery Factor. At the hearing in this case, the Commission dismissed FIPUG's attempt to terminate the Oil Backout Cost Recovery Factor as lacking a legal foundation.
