ORDER AMENDING CERTIFICATE TO INCLUDE
ADDITIONAL TERRITORY

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 1, 1989, Haines Creek Mobile Homesites Waterworks (Haines Creek or Utility) filed an application with the Commission to amend its Certificate No. 130-W to include additional territory in Lake County, Florida, pursuant to the provisions of Section 367.061, Florida Statutes.

On March 17, 1989, Haines Creek notified certificated utilities and appropriate governmental agencies in Lake County of its intention to amend its Certificate to include the territory described in Appendix A, attached to this Order. Proof of Notification has been furnished by the Utility.

Notice of the Utility's intent to extend its service area was published in The Lake Region News, a newspaper of general circulation, published in Lake County, Florida, on April 8, 15, and 22, 1989. No protests to this application were received within the prescribed time period.

The appropriate filing fee has been paid, and the Utility is ready, willing and able to provide service in the territory for which it has applied. The application has been reviewed and found to be in compliance with the statutory requirements. Accordingly, we find it is in the public interest to amend Certificate No. 130-W to include the territory described in Appendix A to this Order, which by reference is incorporated herein.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Certificate No. 130-W, held by Haines Creek Mobile Homesites Waterworks, 34834 Haine Creek Road, Leesburg, Florida 32788, is hereby amended to include the territory described in Appendix A of this Order. The Utility is directed to return Certificate No. 130-W to this Commission within 20 days of the date of this Order for appropriate entry. It is further

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ORDERED that the customers in the territory added herein shall be charged the rates approved in the Utility's tariff. It is further

ORDERED that Haines Creek Mobile Homesites Waterworks shall submit revised tariff sheets reflecting the additional territory as set forth herein within 20 days of the date of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Docket No. 891106-WU is hereby closed.

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NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the

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decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water or sewer utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

In Section 11, Township 19 South, Range 25 East

Commence at the Northeast corner of said Section 11, for a Point of Beginning ; thence S. $89^{\circ}55'30''$ West along the North line of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section, 142.86 feet to a point on the West right-of-way line of County Road No. 473, said point being 40 feet from the centerline of said county road; thence S. $00^{\circ}07'47''$ W. along said West right-of-way line, 720.08 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue S. $00^{\circ}07'47''$ W. along said West right-of-way line, 612.00 feet; thence departing said West right-of-way line and run N. $89^{\circ}56'23''$ W.; 660.00 feet; thence N. $00^{\circ}07'50''$ E., 183.67 feet; thence N. $36^{\circ}22'38''$ E., 501.98 feet; thence N. $86^{\circ}18'09''$ E., 364.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 7.63 acres, more or less.
