ORDER AMENDING CERTIFICATES TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY AND CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

Background

On December 11, 1989, General Development Utilities, Inc. (GDU or Utility) filed an application with this Commission to amend Certificates Nos. 25-W and 22-S in include additional territory in Brevard County. The application was filed pursuant to the provisions of Section 367.045, Florida Statutes.

Application

The application is in compliance with Section 367.045, Florida Statutes, and other pertinent statutes and administrative rules concerning applications for amendment of certificates. In particular, the application contains:

- 1. A filing fee in the amount of \$2,400.00, as prescribed by Rule 25-30.020, Florida Administrative Code.
- 2. Adequate service territory description, Attachment A, and system description, as prescribed by Rule 25-30.035, Florida Administrative Code.
- 3. Evidence that the Utility owns the land upon which the utility's facilities are located, as required by Rule 25-03.035, Florida Administrative Code.
- 4. Proof of notice of the application to all interested governmental and regulatory agencies and all utilities within a four-mile radius of the territory, and proof of advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation in the County, as prescribed by Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code. No objections to the notice have been received and the time for filing such has expired.

The additional territory which GDU proposes to serve is contiguous to territory it is currently authorized to serve. GDU intends to provide a centralized water treatment and distribution system and a centralized wastewater collection, transmission and treatment and disposal system in the territory. GDU has the operating expertise and is financially able to serve the additional area. Therefore, since the growth in the area indicates a need for the service, we find that it is in the public interest to amend GDU's Certificates Nos. 25-W and 22-S to include the territory described in Attachment A of this Order. GDU is directed to file revised tariff sheets reflecting the additional territory within 30 days of the date of this Order.

There is no charge for initiation of a new service or account or reconnections due to temporary disconnects. On reconnections due to other reasons, there is a reconnection charge of \$13.50 for each request during regular working hours. After regular working hours, the charge is \$18.25.

Sewer Reconnection Charge

Sewer service discontinued for nonpayment of bills will be resumed only upon payment of all past due bills and penalties, together with the total cost to the Company of discontinuing and reconnecting sewer service lines.

GDU is directed to charge the customers in the new service area the rates and charges set forth above.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Certificates Nos. 25-W and 22-S, held by General Development Utilities, Inc., 2601 South Bayshore Drive, Miami, Florida 33133-5461, are hereby amended to include the territory described in Attachment A of this Order. The Utility is directed to return Certificates Nos. 25-W and 22-S to this Commission within 30 days of the date of this Order for appropriate entry. It is further

ORDERED that the customers in the territory added herein shall be charged the rates and charges set forth in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that GDU shall submit revised tariff sheets reflecting the additional territory as set forth herein within 30 days of the date of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Docket No. 891361-WS is hereby closed.

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida

Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water or sewer utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
