#### ORDER GRANTING AMENDMENT OF CERTIFICATES

BY THE COMMISSION:

#### Background

On January 29, 1990, General Development Utilities, Inc. (GDU) filed an application for amendment of its Multi-county Certificates Nos. 444-W and 462-S to include additional territory in Charlotte, Desoto and Sarasota Counties (West Coast Division). GDU serves approximately 34,000 water customers and 15,000 sewer customers in the West Coast Division. GDU is wholly-owned by General Development Corporation.

#### Application

The application is in compliance with Section 367.045, Florida Statutes, and other pertinent statutes and administrative rules concerning an application for amendment of a certificate. In particular, the notarized application contains:

- 1. A filing fee in the amount of \$4,500, as prescribed by Rule 25-30.020 Florida Administrative Code.
- 2. Adequate service territory and system maps pursuant to Rule 25-30.035(j), Florida Administrative Code. Said

territory to be served is described as being in Charlotte, Desoto and Sarasota Counties and more particularly as described in Attachment A.

- 3. Proof of notice to all interested governmental and regulatory agencies, and all utilities within a four-mile radius of the territory to be served, and proof of advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation in the county, as prescribed by Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code.
- 4. Evidence that the utility owns land in which the utility's facilities are located as required by Rule 25-30.035(3) (f), Florida Administrative Code.

The territory description referred to in (2) above is not in the format required by Rule 25-30.035(j), Florida Administrative Code, in that it is stated in lots and blocks. We will accept the territory description, as filed, on a temporary basis. However, GDU is directed to furnish territory descriptions and tariff sheets in the format specified in with Rule 25-30.035(h) and (j), Florida Administrative Code, within 120 days of the date of this Order.

The City of North Port filed an objection to GDU's application on February 26, 1990. The objection was withdrawn on March 7, 1990. No other objections to the application have been received.

GDU has systems in Brevard, Marion, Glades and Hendry Counties, and has continuously demonstrated its ability to provide safe and reliable service to its customers. In addition, the Department of Environmental Regulation has no outstanding citations or violations against the utility system at this time.

Therefore, we find that it is in the public interest to amend Certificates Nos. 444-W and 462-S to include the territory shown on Attachment A.

#### NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water or sewer utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900(a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
