ORDER GRANTING TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S MOTION TO DEFER RULING PENDING OUTCOME OF PROTEST

On February 26, 1990, Tampa Electric Company (TECO) received an adverse tentative ruling in Commission Order No. 22596, on the Company's request for specified confidential treatment of portions of the Company's 423 Forms for the month of November, 1989. On March 12, 1990, TECO protested that tentative ruling and requesting a hearing.

Subsequent to the adverse ruling on the November, 1989 Forms TECO has been submitting monthly filings of its Forms 423. These monthly filings contain justifications identical to those contained in TECO's earlier request pertaining to the November, 1989 Forms and in the protest of the adverse rulings. On May 31, 1990, TECO moved to defer rulings on the subsequent filings pending the outcome of the protest. In support of its motion, TECO stated that because any tentative ruling regarding these subsequent filings would presumably be similar to the tentative ruling which is the subject of TECO's protest and request for hearing, TECO would consent to a deferral of any further rulings pending the outcome of the disposition of the Company's protest. TECO stated that the above procedure will save time and avoid expense for all affected persons.

In consideration of the foregoing, it is

ORDERED that Tampa Electric Company's Motion to Defer Ruling on the Company's Form 423 filings pending the outcome of its protest of the tentative ruling regarding Tampa Electric Company's 423 Forms relating to November, 1989, is granted.
