# FIXCA'S MOTION TO INTERVENE

The Florida Interexchange Carriers Association ("FIXCA"), through its undersigned counsel, moves to intervene in the above docket and in support states:

- 2. The name and address of the individuals who should receive copies of orders, notices, pleadings and other communications in this docket are:

3. In the above docket, Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell") has received approval to institute the Market Reach Plan ("plan") on an experimental basis. This plan expands the local calling area and discounts

all intra-LATA toll charges. The plan discounts outgoing calls to the entire LATA in order to make the plan more attractive to customers.

- 4. In approving the plan on an experimental basis, the Commission raised several significant issues:
- a. Will LATA-wide reduced toll rates cover relevant access charges?
- b. Should the plan have increased the number of individual network features available?
- c. Why does the plan not explain the purposes of the trial or the standards by which the trial will be evaluated?
- d. Why does the plan provide for usage sensitive billing where there is a high percentage of nontraffic sensitive costs?
- e. Why are payphone providers and shared tenant service providers unable to subscribe to Market Reach?

  The Commission additionally noted that because the plan projects a loss, Southern Bell will not be able to implement it on a statewide basis. Order No. 22799 at 4.
- 5. Despite these problems, it is contemplated that, depending on the results of the experimental program, Southern Bell may request permanent implementation of this or similar plans. Therefore, it is especially important that the Commission and affected parties review the results of this experimental tariff.

6. FIXCA members provide interexchange service within Florida and in the trial area. As interexchange carriers, FIXCA's substantial interests will be affected by pricing provisions of the experimental plan, their relationship to the local calling aspects of the program, and their relationship to access charges paid by interexchange carriers to provide similar long distance service. Inasmuch as the plan has been approved only on an experimental basis, subject to the submission of data and further evaluation, FIXCA wishes to intervene to protect its interests.

WHEREFORE, FIXCA requests the Commission to enter an order authorizing it to intervene and participate as a full party in the above proceeding.
