### ORDER GRANTING AMENDMENT OF CERTIFICATES TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY

BY THE COMMISSION:

In September, 1989, Gulf Utility Company (Gulf or Utility) noticed its intent to file an application with this Commission for amendment of Certificates Nos. 72-W and 64-S to include additional territory in Lee County. Lee County filed a formal objection to the proposed amendment. Docket No. 891157-WS was opened to resolve that objection.

After negotiations with Lee County, Gulf amended the description of the additional territory. Lee County withdrew its objection on November 13, 1989.

Prior to Lee County's withdrawal of its objection, Gulf filed its application for amendment pursuant to Section 367.061, Florida Statutes. Since Section 367.061, Florida Statutes, states that the application should be filed after construction is complete and the utility is ready to provide service, Gulf's application was premature. Order No. 22522, issued on February 12, 1990, closed Docket No. 891157-WS and advised Gulf that it could ask that its application for amendment of Certificates Nos. 72-W and 64-S be revived and processed once it complied with Section 367.061, Florida Statutes.

On November 26, 1990, Gulf filed a timely request to revive and process its application for amendment of Certificates Nos. 72-W and 64-S. Gulf has now met all of the requirements of Section 367.061, Florida Statutes. Further, Gulf has been in operation in Lee County since 1971 (operating under the name of San Carlos Utilities until 1982 when it changed its name to Gulf Utility Company). Since that time, Gulf has proven that it has the technical and financial ability to provide efficient service to its customers. Therefore, we find that the amendment of Certificates Nos. 72-W and 64-S to include the territory described in Attachment A of this Order is in the public interest and it is approved.

It is, therefore,

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ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the application of Gulf Utility Company, Post Office Box 350, Estero, Florida 33928-0350, to amend Certificates Nos. 72-W and 64-S to include the territory described in Attachment A of this Order is hereby approved. Gulf Utility Company shall return Certificates Nos. 72-W and 64-S to this Commission within 30 days of the date of this Order for entry reflecting the additional territory. It is further

ORDERED that Gulf Utility Company shall charge the customers in the territory added herein the rates and charges approved in its tariff. It is further

ORDERED that Gulf Utility Company shall file tariff sheets reflecting the additional territory within 30 days of the date of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Docket No. 900939-WS is hereby closed.

#### NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that

is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water or sewer utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900 (a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
