ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 3, 1990, Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company (Southern Bell) submitted a revision to its Access Service Tariff establishing a special access surrogate for the payment of intraEAEA toll compensation to the local exchange carriers by interexchange carriers. Southern Bell stated that it filed the tariff in response to Order No. 23540, issued October 1, 1990, in Docket No. 880812-TP. In that Order, we put all parties on notice that the development of special access compensation requirements should proceed quickly to achieve a meaningful compensation level during the time remaining for toll monopoly areas (TMAs).

On December 19, 1990, the Florida Interexchange Carriers Association filed a Petition for Rejection of Southern Bell's tariff. Both US Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership and MCI Telecommunications Corporation have since intervened in this docket. Compensation paid on special access is an issue that has been raised in the reconsideration of Order No. 23540, in Docket No. 880812-T. Given the outstanding issues in Docket No. 880812-TP, we hereby order that Southern Bell's tariff be suspended, and addressed in conjunction with our decision in the Reconsideration of Order No. 23540.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company's tariff filing establishing a special access surrogate is hereby suspended. It is further
