Dear Mr. Garringer:

As I related to you in our conversation yesterday, we have completed our search pursuant to the public records request received by the Commission on April 9, 1991, from the Attorney General. Our search of our records has produced the following:

1. Audits of possible falsification of repair records - No audits with the specific goal of discovering falsification of repair records have been performed. There have been a number of financial accounting audits of Southern Bell activities devoted to various subjects. Attachment 1 is a list of these audits involving Southern Bell. Since these documents have been archived we cannot be certain that some portion of them does not relate to your request. We have asked that the documents be returned. The documents should be returned from archives within a couple of days. As soon as we receive the documents you can review them to retrieve any information relating to your request.

The Commission has also conducted two audits of Southern Bell's managerial operations. A cross-sectional management audit was conducted in 1985 comparing Southern Bell with other local exchange companies. The audit did not reveal any falsification of repair records but did evaluate the service and repair functions. The relevant portion of the audit report is being provided. The Commission is currently in the final stages of completing another management audit of Southern Bell.

2. Inquiries of Possible Falsification of Repair Records - This Commission has not initiated any inquiries pursuant to Section 350.121, Florida Statutes, regarding possible falsification of repair records by Southern Bell.

- 3. <u>Subpoenaes Issued</u> The Commission has no record of any subpoenaes being issued in conjunction of a probe of possible falsification of repair records.
- 4. <u>Documents and Reports of Investigations</u> All such documents have been compiled and are available for your inspection. A summary list of these documents is attached as Attachment 2.
- 5. <u>Southern Bell Tutorial Documents</u> These documents have been compiled and are available for your inspection. Please note, however, that nine Commission employees attended the tutorial presented by Southern Bell regarding Southern Bell's automated trouble reporting system. Two of the employees are no longer employed by the Commission. Of the remaining employees five of the nine are currently out of the office on leave or on Commission business. The personal files of those individuals not in the office were examined but it is possible that relevant documents do exist in these files. If, when these individuals return, they have any responsive documents you will be contacted immediately and the documents will be made available to you.
- 6. Attendance Sheets And Notes From Tutorial These documents have been compiled and are available for your inspection. As described above in response to your request No. 5, if the individuals that may possess relevant documents find any such documents on their return, you will be notified immediately and these documents will be made available to you.

With respect to your request for the names of all persons that were aware, prior to January 1, 1991, of reports of possible falsification of repair records, there are no documents that contain such a list. However, it appears that certain individuals may have had some knowledge of the allegations of falsification of repair records. A list of these persons is attached as Attachment 3. It does not appear that anyone at Southern Bell was informed of the allegations of possible falsification of reports.
