All traffic data collected for the one-way calling rate computation for Gilchrist County was based on the January 1991 billing period. Calling main stations for this study included 1B, 2B, Semi-Public Paystations, PBX Trunks, Key System Lines, Centrex, Customer-Owned Paystations, 1R, and 2R. Calling main totals differ from access line totals. Access line totals include Public Paystations and Special Services (Private Lines). Totals on both counts exclude test lines and official company lines.

Combined two-way data is only available for the Branford-High Springs, High Springs-Branford route.

Calling statistics for the one-way Branford-Trenton, Branford-Newberry, Branford-High Springs, and High Springs-Trenton, High Springs-Branford routes and composite two way Branford-High Springs are as follows:

The exchange of Branford is presently served by a NXID (North Electric Crossbar) Switch. The exchange of High Springs is served by a DMS-10 (Northern Telecom) office.

Presently all toll traffic for Branford to High Springs, Trenton and Newberry, and High Springs toll to Trenton is carried over Fiber through the Live Oak switch to High Springs or to Jacksonville 05T lata Tandem and reswitched via Gainesville to Trenton and Newberry. High Springs is also switched thru Live Oak to Branford. High Springs EAS to Newberry is direct to Gainesville tandem thru the Alachua office. Depending on the connecting company network we would probably have to reroute the new EAS traffic for Branford via Live Oak to Jacksonville and for High Springs via Alachua to Gainesville. Jacksonville and Gainesville would then have to tandem this traffic to Trenton and Newberry.

The communities of interest for the Gilchrist county citizens residing in Branford, Newberry and High Springs areas are: Governmental offices, including the School Board, Courthouse offices, public officials, banks and other businesses.

All toll revenue between Branford and High Springs is intralata and is being billed under MABC. The originating toll is kept by ALLTEL and no terminating access payment is required since this route is intra company. The toll revenue for the Branford-Trenton, Branford-Newberry, High Springs-Trenton routes are Intrastate/Interlata and is turned over to AT&T. ALLTEL's interlata lost revenue would be in terms of access charges billed to AT&T.

## ANALYSIS STATEMENT Docket No. 870790-TL Gilchrist County EAS POCKET

All traffic data collected for the one-way calling rate computation for Gilchrist County was based on the January 1991 billing period. Calling main stations for this study included 1B, 2B, Semi-Public Paystations, PBX Trunks, Key System Lines, Centrex, Customer-Owned Paystations, 1R, and 2R. Calling main totals differ from access line totals. Access line totals include Public Paystations and Special Services (Private Lines). Totals on both counts exclude test lines and official company lines.

Pocket studies can only reflect calling volumes for pocket areas within the <u>originating</u> exchange to another NXX in its entirety. Studies of pocket areas to other pocket areas is not available within our data systems at this time. For example, Branford pocket area calling to Trenton reflects calling from telephone numbers in the Branford pocket area of Gilchrist county to the entire exchange of Trenton, not just the Gilchrist county pocket area in Trenton.
