Staff has reviewed the application for a water certificate in Highlands County by C & H Utilities, Inc. (C&H). The following is a list of deficiencies that must be satisfied before we can complete the processing of the application:

The territory description must be corrected so that it follows the format prescribed in Rule 25-30.030(4)(b), Florida Administrative Code, (FAC). A detailed explanation for preparing a legal description

FA	2.	The notice of application, filed as Exhibit 4 & 5 of the application,
PP		must be corrected to reflect the 30 day period for filing objections, the
AF		correct territory description, and given in accordance with Rule 25-

File an affidavit that the notice of actual application was given in
accordance with Section 367.045(1)(a), Florida Statutes (FS), and Rule
25-30.030, FAC, by certified mail or personal delivery to the governing
body of the county in which the system is located, the governing body
of any municipality within a four (4) mile radius of the territory, any
water or wastewater utility within a four (4) mile radius of the
territory, the regional planning agency, the Public Counsel and the
Public Service Commission. Copies of the notice and a list of entities
noticed shall accompany the affidavit. A copy of the list of entities
that must be noticed within the 4 mile radius is enclosed.

- 4. File an affidavit that the notice of actual application was given in accordance with Rule 25-30.030, FAC, by certified mail or personal delivery to each customer of the system. A copy of the notice shall accompany the affidavit.
- 5. File an affidavit that the notice of actual application was published once each week for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory in accordance with Rule 25-30.030, FAC. Copies of the advertisements shall accompany the affidavit.
- 6. File a statement regarding the applicant's financial ability to continue to provide service, as required under Rule 25-30.034(1)(d), F.A.C.

Additional information, as listed below, is also needed:

- Date that utility began operations.
- Date that C&H purchased the system.
- Annual revenues and operating income (loss) for the calendar year that ended Decemer 31, 1990.
- 4. Why did it take C&H so long to file for a certificate after purchasing the system?
- 5. The sample tariff is being returned for correction. Staff is particularly concerned about the service availability charges. The meter installation charges and customer connection charges can not be combined for some meter sizes and meter installation charges added to the same connection charge for other meter sizes. This would result in double charging for meters to a certain extent. Therefore, the customer connection charges and meter installation charges on page 23.0 of the tariff will need to be identified separately. Other tariff changes are identified in red on the working copy of the sample tariff.
