## AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Order No. 25312, we granted in part and denied in part motions for reconsideration and/or clarification filed in response to Order No. 24101.

Shortly after issuance of Order No. 25312, it came to our attention that an effective date was misstated in the Order. Page three (3) of Order No. 25312 states that Order No. 24101 requires all LECs to file tariffs to become effective sixty (60) days following the issuance date of the Order on reconsideration. That statement is not correct. In actuality, Order No. 24101 requires all LECs to file tariffs to become effective ninety (90) days following the issuance date of the order on reconsideration. Accordingly, Order No. 25312 shall be so amended.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. 25312 is amended to the extent outlined in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. 25312 is affirmed in all other respects. It is further

ORDERED that this docket shall remain open.
