As was discussed during our meeting of April 6, 1992, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a/ Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or the "Company") hereby notifies the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") that Southern Bell does not object to the postponement of hearings in the above-referenced docket until the tentatively scheduled dates of January 25-29, February 1, 3-5 and February 8-12, 1993. Because Southern Bell's present Rate Stabilization Plan is currently scheduled to expire as of December 31, 1992, the Company also agrees that any decision rendered by the Commission, which is now anticipated to be rendered in the March to April of 1993 time frame, will be made retroactive to January 1, 1993.

It is Southern Bell's understanding that its direct testimony will be scheduled to be filed with the Commission by July 15, 1992. At that same time, Southern Bell will file such revised minimum filing requirements as may be necessary to reflect proposals contained in the Company's pre-filed testimony. Any such revisions will be filed on paper of a color different than white so that the revisions can easily be identified.
