The Florida Consumer Action Network (FCAN) hereby requests the Florida Public Service Commission to reschedule the service hearings in the above-mentioned docket, which are currently scheduled to commence on August 3, 1992.

3. Many of Southern Bell's customers are seasonal residents of Florida, and will not return to the state until later in the fall. By allowing the service hearings to continue as currently scheduled, these customers are effectively precluded from offering comment to the Commission on these important issues which directly affect them.

4. Intervenor testimony is currently scheduled to be filed in early November, at which time the issues in this case should be more fully developed. By rescheduling the service hearings to November and December from August and September, affected consumers and the Commission will benefit through more informed and relevant public comment concerning this case.

WHEREFORE, FCAN respectfully requests the Florida Public Service Commission to reschedule the service hearings in this case from August and September 1992 to November and December 1992.
