ORDER GRANTING CERTIFICATE

BY THE COMMISSION:

Background

On April 24, 1992, Hunter's Ridge Utility Company of Lee County (Hunter's Ridge) filed an application with this Commission for a wastewater certificate in Lee County. Hunter's Ridge currently serves approximately 175 customers. At build-out, the system will serve approximately 750 equivalent residential connections (ERCs) in the Hunter's Ridge subdivision. The utility is in an area that has been designated by the South Florida Water Management District as a critical use area. Hunter's Ridge proposes to utilize reuse by means of a spray irrigation system serving the golf course area inside the Hunter's Ridge Development.

The original developer, Beau Kastle Developers, Inc., (Beau Kastle) began construction of single family and multifamily residential dwelling units together with a clubhouse, golf cart storage building, and golf cart maintenance building on the South Parcel of Hunter's Ridge. On July 7, 1986, the Department of Environmental Regulation (DER) issued a wastewater treatment facility construction permit to the utility for a 25,000 gallons per day plant. Wastewater service began in August 1988. After approximately 125 residential dwelling units were completed, Lee County required that the wastewater treatment facility be expanded from the then existing 25,000 gallons per day capacity to a 100,000 gallons per day capacity before allowing any additional building permits on the South Parcel. Subsequently, on November 20, 1989, DER issued the wastewater treatment facility upgrade construction permit.

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On September 15, 1989, Beau Kastle defaulted on promissory notes owed to investors. After a foreclosure action was initiated against Beau Kastle in February 1990, it agreed to transfer ownership of the wastewater treatment facility to Hunter's Ridge. As a result of this transaction, which closed June 14, 1990, Hunter's Ridge assumed the responsibility for operation and expansion of the existing wastewater treatment facility.

Application

The application is in compliance with Section 367.045, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.035, Florida Administrative Code. Hunter's Ridge paid the appropriate filing fee and provided proof of ownership of the land upon which the utility's facilities are located. Adequate territory and system maps have been filed. A description of the territory is appended as Attachment A. Noticing requirements have been met in accordance with Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code. No objections to the application have been filed with this Commission, and the time for filing such has expired.

The utility is currently operating the wastewater system and has retained a management company to perform the day-to-day operations of the wastewater treatment facilities. We have reviewed the financial statements of the developers and the stockholders who are providing the funding of the construction and expansion. Based upon our review, we find the utility has adequate funds and resources for continued operation of the system. Further, Hunter's Ridge has provided this Commission with signed statements from its principal stockholders indicating that these shareholders will continue to provide financial backing to the utility for its operation.

Our review indicates that no conflict will exist with local comprehensive plans. There currently are no other utilities which could provide service at this time.

Based on the above, we find that it is in the public interest to grant Hunter's Ridge Utility Company of Lee County Wastewater Certificate No. 472-S for the area described in Attachment A.

Rates and Charges

Hunter's Ridge has provided sufficient information to determine rates and charges for the utility. After we have completed our analysis of the data submitted, appropriate rates and

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charges will be set for this utility. The utility shall not charge for wastewater service prior to the final establishment of authorized rates and charges by this Commission.

Based on the foregoing, it is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Hunter's Ridge Utility Co. of Lee County, 12500 Hunter's Ridge Drive, Bonita Springs, Florida 33923, is hereby granted Wastewater Certificate No. 472-S to provide wastewater service to the territory described in Attachment A of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Hunter's Ridge Utility Co. of Lee County shall not charge for service prior to the approval of appropriate rates and charges by this Commission. It is further

ORDERED that this docket shall remain open to establish rates and charges for this Utility.

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

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Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water or sewer utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Civil Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900 (a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
