Dear Mr. Sims:

I write in response to your letter sent to me by facsimile transmission August 14, 1992.

In your letter, you state that based on your review of the appellate court materials, you do not think that the utility has an approved rate. This is not the case. The focus of the appeal is the period of time in 1991 when the Circuit Court injunction was in effect.

In your letter you also state that you intend not to respond to any staff correspondence until the appellate court case is concluded. I would strongly suggest that you not do this. The disposition of the court case and the show cause proceeding currently pending before the Commission have nothing to do with each other. Any lack of cooperation with staff on your part would not be well received by the Commission in light of the problems the utility has had in the past.

In your letter you also state, "Concerning our conversation with you and Ms. Lingo last week, we are in agreement but then still this is all up to the appellate court." I am unaware of our being in agreement on anything in the show cause matter which was the subject of our most recent conversation on July 29. Further, I fail to understand your reference to our supposed agreement being subject to the appellate court's decision.

Finally, in your letter, you request an extension on the administrative hearing to be held on August 22, until the appellate court makes its decision. I call your attention to the fact that

there is no hearing in the show cause matter scheduled for August 22. The utility's prefiled testimony is due August 21; the hearing is scheduled for December 9 and 10. If you want an extension for filing your testimony or want to have the hearing continued, you need to make your request by a formal written request filed in accordance with Rule 25-22.037, Florida Administrative Code, and all other applicable Commission Rules.

Dear Mr. Feil:

I noted following the brief I picked up from Mr. McAlvanah's office today, it was dated 5-28-92. It appears to me that we do not even have a rate until the Appellate Court makes its decision.

We have received numerous pieces of correspondence from Staff, that would appear after reviewing the appeal, that it would not behoove us to answer this correspondence until the Appellate Court makes its decision. As you know, we certainly want to bring this to a conclusion, because the expenses involved are not within the area of the Utility's financial position. We would like to bring this to a conclusion, but then it appears that we are in some type of a quagmire.

Concerning our conversation with you and Miss Lingo last week, we are in agreement but then still this is all up to the Appellate Court. We shall run this Utility in accordance with the funds available. Enclosed is a complete listing of non-payment of Utility Fees as of 6-19-92.

We would like to request an extension for an administrative hearing which is to be held on August 22, 1992, until the Appellate Court makes its final decision. I believe this would be the most logical and economical thing to do for all parties involved. We appreciate your consideration.
