- 4. With respect to Southern Bell's response to Item No. 1, the information requested is information of a personal nature relating to certain Company employees, and such information is unrelated to compensation, duties, qualifications, or responsibilities. Such information is expressly exempt from the public inspection and examination provisions of § 119.07(1), Florida Statutes pursuant to § 364.183(3)(f), Florida Statutes. Moreover, the legitimate privacy interests of these individuals must be taken into consideration in this case where these employees' personal information is being sought in a public proceeding.
- 5. All of the information for which Southern Bell requests confidential treatment is intended to be treated as confidential, has been treated as confidential and has not been disclosed to any third party except pursuant to statutory provisions or private agreement that provides that the information will not be released to the public.
