<u>Issue 3:</u> Recommendation that Turkey Creek Utilities should be required to begin charging those rates which it was charging on June 30, 1992, on the next billing for service. In addition, Turkey Creek should be required to refund monies collected from its customers pursuant to the two unauthorized rate increases. Further, the utility should be ordered to pay interest on the overcharge, calculated in accordance with Rule 25-30.360, F.A.C., that has accrued or will accrue until the date of refund. The refund should be accomplished within ninety days from the effective date of the order and the utility should be required to file reports consistent with Rule 25-30.360, F.A.C. In the event these refunds are unclaimed, staff recommends that all unclaimed amounts be treated as cash contributions-in-aid-of-construction (CIAC).
