SOUTHERN BELL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.037, Florida Administrative Code, and hereby moves the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") for a thirty-day extension of time in which to file a traffic study in response to Order No. PSC-93-0029-PCO-TL, entered in the above-referenced docket, and as grounds in support thereof states the following:

1. Commission Order No. PSC-93-0029-PCO-TL, issued on January 6, 1993, directed Southern Bell to prepare and submit within 90 days a traffic study of the routes between all exchanges in Palm Beach County. Thus, under the Order, the required traffic study would be due on or before April 6, 1993.

2. The required study is unusually complex in that it will require the analysis described in the Order for each of 45 different routes between all the exchanges in Palm Beach County. Due to the complexity of this study, it will require a longer than usual time to complete. Specifically, Southern Bell will likely be unable to complete the study within the time required by the Order. The grant of an additional 30 days to respond to the Order, however, will allow Southern Bell adequate time to complete this study (i.e., until May 6, 1993).

3. The requested extension will not prejudice any party to this proceeding. Further, it will allow Southern Bell adequate time to provide this Commission with the information necessary to reach an informed decision in this matter.

WHEREFORE, Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a thirty-day extension, until May 6, 1993, in which to respond to Order No. PSC-93-0029-PCO-TL.
