COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Division Code, and files its Request for Confidential Classification for the Company's Response to Item Nos. 428 and 429 of Staff's Sixteenth Set of Interrogatories dated November 25, 1992.

It contains actual and perceived traffic demand over specific toll routes. disclosure of this highly valuable competitive toll market information would impair Southern Bell's ability to compete in the intraLATA toll market. Competitors could use the information to target the most lucrative routes. Section 364.183(e), Florida Statutes, expressly considers as proprietary confidential business information any information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider. The information contained in Southern Bell's Response to Interrogatory Item Nos. 428 and 429, as more specifically described above, meets the statutory criteria, and should therefore be afforded confidential classification.
- 6. Southern Bell has treated and intends to continue to treat the material for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, Southern Bell moves the Prehearing Officer to enter an order declaring the information
