Records indicate your meter was removed on July 6, 1992 when a meterman observed evidence of tampering. The meter was tested and found to have a missing inner seal, drag marks on the bottom of the disk, a tampered bearing screw, and shiny blades.

The backbilling covers the period from July, 1987 to July, 1992, as the company noted low kilowatt hour usage throughout your period of occupancy. The company calculated the additional kilowatt hours by using a methodology based on seasonal charts as a means of determining the actual amount of energy consumed. This estimating formula is sensitive to normal heating and cooling demands of the average residential customer in your area. Since FPL believed that you may have inherited the tampered meter condition when you moved to the residence in 1987, it did not bill any investigative charges. However, FPL did backbill for the electricity that was used in the residence and not recorded on the meter.

I can understand your concern over the billing. However, Florida Public Service Commission rules allow the company to backbill in the event of meter tampering based on a reasonable estimate of energy used but not billed. Although you may not have created the tampered meter condition, FPL is within its rights in backbilling you. It is not vital for FPL to prove who tampered with the meter, but just that the condition exists, and the customer of record benefitted from the condition.

I wish I could resolve every complaint to the complete satisfaction of the customer, but sometimes this isn't possible. FPL is acting within its rights and under commission guidelines in backbilling you for the tampered meter condition.
