INTERMEDIA COMMUNICATIONS OF FLORIDA, INC.'S NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Intermedia Communications of Florida, Inc. (ITI), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification.

1. On June 29, 1993, the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission (Staff) served by U. S. Mail its First Set of Interrogatories to ITI. On August 2, 1993, ITI served its responses to Interrogatories 1 - 5, and 7 - 36. ITI objected to Question 6 as requiring submission of proprietary confidential business information, and committed that it would file the appropriate pleading by separate cover. This Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification is filed pursuant to ITI's objection.

2. The information which is responsive to Question 6 is information which ITI believes is proprietary confidential business information, and is of a type this Commission has found in past dockets to be confidential. The question solicits a list of certain of ITI's customers, together with: (a) information regarding the percentage of private line and special access revenue associated with each; and (b) information regarding the percentage of total revenue for each.


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3. ITI believes that information of this type is within the scope of Section 364.183(3), Florida Statutes, and must be afforded protection as "proprietary confidential business information."

4. Accordingly, because this information contains proprietary information, ITI is filing this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, in order to allow the Staff to review this information without delay. Both the original of this notice and a copy of Staff's First Interrogatories to ITI have been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on the Division requesting the information. A copy of Question 6 is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

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
