Re: Docket No. Tr., Petition of Intermedia Communications of Florida, Inc. for Expanded Interconnection for AAVs within LEC Central Offices.

Dear Tracy:

In accordance with our discussions at the Prehearing Conference in the above-referenced docket, please be advised that AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. ("AT&T"), the Florida Interexchange Carriers Association ("FIXCA"), and MCI Telecommunications Corporation ("MCI") have agreed to stipulate Issue 10. The issue and the stipulation are as follows:

ISSUE: Should the same terms and conditions of expanded interconnection apply to AT&T as apply to other interconnectors?

STIPULATION: AT&T should be allowed to interconnect intrastate Special Access Arrangements to the same extent as other parties, subject to the requirements adopted by the FCC in CC Docket 91-141 regarding preexisting collocated facilities.

The foregoing stipulation was agreed to by Joe Gillan on behalf of FIXCA, Mickey Henry on behalf of MCI, and myself on behalf of AT&T. It is our understanding that no other parties have disputed this position and consequently the stipulation should be agreeable to all concerned.

Approval of this stipulation will permit FIXCA to withdraw the Direct Testimony of Joe Gillan and will
