UTILITIES UNIT 2, INC. TO SUMTER WATER COMPANY, INC.

On June 22, 1993, USA Utilities, Unit 2, Inc. (USA) filed a request for a name change to Sumter Water Company, Inc. In its request, the utility stated that this name change is necessary because it has operations which do not fall under the jurisdiction of the Commission and by changing its name, it would separate the regulated portion from the nonregulated portion. In addition, it included a copy of the Articles of Incorporation showing the Secretary of State's acceptance of the new name, a statement by an officer that the ownership and control of the utility and its assets will not change under the proposed name change, revised tariffs reflecting the new name of the utility, and its current certificates.

In addition to the above documentation, USA filed a sample notice to be sent to the customers of the utility informing them of the name change. Staff advised the utility to include the information found in Rule 25-30.330(1)(a) and (b), Florida Administrative Code, regarding the address and telephone number of the utility with the data already found in the notice. The utility will send the notice in early September.

Based on the above, an order should be issued within thirty days acknowledging USA Utilities, Unit 2, Inc's request to change its name to Sumter Water Company and closing the docket.
