

4. The Commission issued its Notice of Proposed Agency Action Order No. PSC-93-1771-FOF-WS on December 10, 1993, and which granted until December 31, 1993 to petition for a formal proceeding. **Petitioner never received such order.**

5. Petitioner hereby protests the findings of Order No. PSC- 93-1771-FOF-WS, and takes issue with, among other things, the manner in which the proposed increased rates will be implemented, which will result in a significant amount of taxes being paid indirectly by Sanlando's customers. 
