PURPOSE AND EFFECT: This rule is amended to update the versions of the National Electrical Safety Code and the National Electric Code that telecommunications companies are required to comply with in the design and construction of their facilities.

SUMMARY: Rule 25-4.036 requires telecommunications utilities to design and construct their plant and facilities in accordance with the provisions of the 1993 National Electrical Safety Code and the 1993 National Electric Code.

THE FULL TEXT OF THE RULE IS:

25-4.036 Design and Construction of Plant.

- (1) The plant and facilities of the utility shall be designed, constructed, installed, maintained and operated in accordance with provisions of the 1993-1990 Edition of the National Electrical Safety Code (ANSI C2-19931990), except that Rule 350G of the safety code shall be effective for cable installed on or after January 1, 1996, and the National Electrical Code (NFPA 70-19931990), pertaining to the construction of telecommunications facilities.
- (2) Compliance with these codes and accepted good practice is necessary to insure as far as reasonably possible continuity of service, uniformity in the quality of service furnished and the safety of persons and property.
