An incompany continuous contraction related shall be applied to each kilowatt-hour delivered and shall reflect increases or decreases to the meanest .001¢ per KWH to recover the conservation related expenditures of the Company. The procedure for the review, approval, recovery and recording of such costs and revenues is set forth in Commission Rule 25-17.15, F.A.C.

OIL BACKOUT COST RECOVERY CLAUSE

An oil backout cost recovery factor shall be applied to each kilowatt-hour delivered, and shall reflect increases or decreases to the nearest .001¢ per KWH to recover the cost of the Company's oil to coal conversion of Gannon Units 1 through 4 (the "Project"), as approved by the Florida Public Service Commission.
