MOTION TO DISMISS

Comes Now, Applicant, RESORT VILLAGE UTILITY, INC., and moves that this

Commission dismiss the objections to the application for certificate of authorization filed herein,

cancel the hearing set in this matter and authorize Commission Staff to review and

administratively approve the application. As grounds therefore, Resort Village Utility states:

1. Resort Village Utility has filed an application for a certificate of authorization to

provide wastewater service in Franklin County, Florida. The property encompassed within the

proposed certificated area is entirely owned by an affiliate of Resort Village Utility.

2. Five timely objections to that application were filed: Document No. 12268-93 by

Lusia Dende-Gallio, Document No. 12315-93 by Cindy Stock, Document No. 12314-93 by Harry

Buzzett, Document No. 12522-93 by Thomas H. Adams and Document No. 13374-93 by D.E.

Findley.

3. None of the objections requested a hearing in this matter. None of the objections

allege, nor could they allege, that the person filing the objection is or will be a consumer of the

utility. None of the objections allege that the objector is in any way substantially affected by the

requested certification.

4. The objections uniformly center on environmental issues, alleging that discharge

from the proposed wastewater treatment plant may be environmentally harmful to Apalachicola

Bay. The objections of Gallio, Adams and Stock also allege that there may be water availability

problems within the proposed certificated area. None of the objections allege injury to an interest

which is of the type or nature designed to be protected by the certification procedure.

DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE

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5. Pursuant to Section 367.045(4), Florida Statutes (1993), the Commission is required to hold a hearing on an application for a certificate of authorization if a "consumer who would be substantially affected by the requested certification" files a written objection seeking a Section 120.57 hearing. No such objection has been filed in this docket.

6. Resort Village Utility currently has pending an application with the Department of Environmental Protection for the construction of a wastewater treatment facility within the proposed certificated area. The certificate of authorization sought in this proceeding is one of the last items required by the Department of Environmental Protection prior to issuance of that permit. Any delay in this docket will result in substantial financial hardship to Resort Village Utility.

WHEREFORE, Resort Village Utility requests that this Commission dismiss the objections filed herein, cancel the hearing set herein and authorize Commission Staff to review and administratively approve the application.
