GTE FLORIDA INCORPORATED'S
MOTION FOR TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER

Under Commission Rule 25-22.006(5)(c), GTE Florida Incorporated (GTEFL) requests a temporary protective order exempting from Florida Statutes section 119.07(1) certain material produced in response to the Public Service Commission Staff's (Staff) Second Request for Production of Documents. By agreement with the Staff, GTEFL will produce at its Tallahassee office all of the materials the Staff has requested. Staff will review the documents and decide what, if any, information it wishes to use in this proceeding. If Staff indicates its intention to use any confidential information, GTEFL will at that time submit a more detailed request for confidential treatment of the specified documents.

All of the information for which GTEFL seeks confidential protection falls within Florida Statutes section 364.183(3)(e), which defines the terms "proprietary confidential business information to include "information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of that information." The confidential information in this filing includes the Company's forecasts about the impact of switched and special access interconnection on GTEFL's revenues and expenses, as well as information about which


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entities have requested collocation in which central offices. In a competitive business, any such knowledge obtained about a competitor can be used to the detriment of the entity to which it pertains. This unfair advantage skews the operation of the market, to the ultimate detriment of the ratepayer.

For these reasons, GTEFL asks the Commission to issue a temporary protective order covering the confidential information contained in documents produced by GTEFL in response to Staff's Second Request for Production of Documents.


