expanded interconnection and local transport restructure. Among the issues to be addressed are whether to require physical or virtual collocation of equipment in the central office, whether additional pricing flexibility should be granted, and the effects of interconnection on the local exchange companies and their ratepayers; to permit any intervenors to present testimony and exhibits concerning this matter; and for such other purposes as the Commission may deem appropriate. At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on August 10, 1994. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony. The proceedings will be governed by the provisions of Chapter 120, F. S., and Chapter 25-22, F. A. C. Any person requiring some accommodation at this hearing because of a physical impairment should call the Division of Records and Reporting at (904)488-8371 at least five calendar days prior to the hearing.
