#### COMMISSION STAFF'S PREHEARING STATEMENT

### A. <u>All Known Witnesses</u>

Staff does not intend to call any witnesses.

### B. All Known Exhibits

Staff does not intend to sponsor any exhibits. However, Staff reserves the right to identify exhibits for the purpose of cross-examination.

### C. <u>Staff's Statement of Basic Position</u>

It appears that the reuse plan offered by Sanlando Utilities Corporation (Sanlando) will accomplish the stated goal of conservation. Staff is not convinced, however, that a surcharge is the appropriate way to fund the plan.

<u>ISSUE 2</u>: If the water conservation plan is approved, should the surcharge be subject to regulatory assessment fees?

POSITION: No.

<u>ISSUE 3</u>: If the water conservation plan is approved, should the surcharge be used to offset underearnings that may occur as a result of decreased water consumption?

POSITION: No.

- ISSUE 4: If the water conservation plan is approved, how should the utility retain and utilize the funds collected under the plan?
- <u>POSITION</u>: The funds should be placed in escrow. Sanlando should provide quarterly reports of funds collected, funds expended, and estimated completion costs.
- <u>ISSUE 5</u>: If the water conservation plan is approved, how long should the surcharge remain in effect?
- <u>POSITION</u>: Until the rationale for collecting the charge has expired.
- <u>ISSUE 6</u>: If the water conservation plan is approved, how should the surcharge be booked?
- <u>POSITION</u>: The surcharge should be booked as contributions in aid of construction.
- <u>ISSUE 7</u>: If the water conservation plan is approved, how should the reuse plant be booked?
- <u>POSITION</u>: The reuse plant should be booked as a separate subaccount of Account No. 380, Treatment and Disposal Equipment.
