COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company") and files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Motion for Extension of Duration of Order Granting Confidential Classification, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

1. On November 10, 1992, Southern Bell filed a Request for Confidential Classification of material provided in the Company's Minimum Filing Requirements (MFR) revisions. The Commission assigned Document No. 13249-92 to this material.

2. By an Order issued March 17, 1993, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") granted Southern Bell's Request

for Confidential Classification of information contained in this document. (Order No. PSC-93-0413-CFO-TL) Specifically, the Commission approved Southern Bell's request for confidential classification of information on feature-specific costs associated with universal service order codes for ESSX service found in Schedule E1A of the MFR filing.

3. Under the provision of Rule 25-22.006 (8) (a), an order granting confidential classification is effective for 18 months. Therefore, the confidential classification granted in this Order expires on September 17, 1994. The Commission may, however, extend the period of confidentiality for good cause shown.

4. The reasons Southern Bell asserted in support of confidential treatment in its original motion continue to pertain. Specifically, there is still a need to protect the information regarding the cost of providing ESSX service from disclosure.

5. For the reasons set forth above and in the original Request for Confidential Classification filed on November 10, 1992, Southern Bell hereby requests that this Commission enter an Order extending the period of confidential classification for an additional 18 months, or for any longer period of time that the documents remain within the possession of staff.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, Southern Bell respectfully requests the entry of an Order extending the period of confidential classification as described above.
