Upon your request, we have researched the appropriate date for filing the service availability case as ordered by Order No. PSC-93-0423-FOF-WS in Docket No. 920199-WS. Order No. PSC-93-0423-FOF-WS, issued March 22, 1993, required Southern States Utilities, Inc. (SSU or utility) to file an application for service availability charges within two years of the date of the Order.

Subsequent to the issuance of this Order, several motions for reconsideration were filed by various parties and non-parties.
