The Commission should determine that City Gas has properly calculated its conservation cost recovery true-up and projections and that the appropriate conservation cost recovery factor to be applied by City Gas during the period April 1995 through March 1996

is .07563 cents per therm for the residential rate class and .01919 cents per therm for the commercial rate class.
