25. The information requested includes customer specific information and confidential business information which are clearly proprietary. Such information is specifically considered to be proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to § 364.183(3), (3)(c) and (3)(e), Florida Statutes.

Consequently, because this information contains proprietary information, Southern Bell is filing this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, in order to allow the Staff to review this information without delay. Both the original of this notice and the individual requests have been filed with the Division of Records and Reporting, and a copy has been served on the Division requesting the information. The written 5 aff requests are attached hereto.
