Earnings Surveillance Report

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The rule amendment relieves electric utilities with less than 50,000 customers of the burden of monthly earnings surveillance reports by requiring quarterly reports instead.

SUMMARY: Electric utilities with 50,000 or more customers are required to file monthly earnings surveillance reports by the 15th day of the second month following the reported month. Those with less than 50,000 customers are required to file quarterly earnings surveillance reports by the 15th day of the second month following the reported month.

In response to written requests to the Division of Auditing and Financial Analysis prior to the due date of the report, one 31-day extension will be granted. Requests for a longer extension must be accompanied by a statement of good cause and must specify the date the report will be filed.

## 25-6.1352 Earnings Surveillance Report.

- (1) Each <u>investor-owned</u> electric utility shall file rate of return data using Commission Form PSC/AFA 14 (6/94), which is incorporated by reference into this rule. Form PSC/AFA 14, entitled "Investor-Owned Electric Utility Earnings Surveillance Report," may be obtained from the Commission's Division of Auditing and Financial Analysis.
- (2) The report shall be filed: monthly by the 15th day of the second month following the month being reported.
- (a) Monthly, by the 15th day of the second month following the reported month for electric utilities with 50,000 or more customers.
- (b) Quarterly, by the 15th day of the second month following the reported quarter for electric utilities with less than 50,000 customers.
- (3) A utility may file a written request for an extension of time with the Division of Auditing and Financial Analysis prior to the due date of the report. One extension of 31 days will be

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granted upon request. A request for Commission approval of a longer extension must be accompanied by a statement of good cause and shall specify the date by which the report will be filed. Requests for extensions of time in which to file the report must be submitted in writing to the Commission prior to the due date of the report.
