AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 20, 1995, this Commission issued Order No. PSC-95-1570-FOF-WS, which suspended proposed rates and granted an interim rate increase subject to refund for Rotonda West Utility Corporation (Rotonda or utility). The Order contained two instances where our decision in this matter was not properly indicated.

Page 4 of the Order includes the following sentence:

Based upon our decisions regarding rate base, cost of capital and net operating income, we find it appropriate to grant Rotonda interim rates designed to allow the utility the opportunity to generate annual operating revenues of \$318,719 for its water operations and \$83,541 for its wastewater operations.

That portion of Order No. PSC-95-1570-FOF-WS is hereby amended to properly indicate that the utility has the opportunity to generate additional annual operating revenues of \$318,719 for water and \$83,541 for wastewater.

Page 5 of the Order includes the following sentence:

If a refund to the customers is required, all interest earned by the escrow account shall be distributed to the customers.

That portion of Order No. PSC-95-1570-FOF-WS is hereby amended to properly indicate that the interest shall be distributed to the customers in proportion to the amount of refund to be made and distributed from the escrow account.

Order No. PSC-95-1570-FOF-WS is affirmed in all other respects.


