This is to voice our concerns regarding the proposed expansion of water and sewer services by Spruce Creek South Utilities.

For an extended duration (days) during the first week in February, 1996, we experienced a very large drop in water pressure to our home. Not knowing the nature of the problem, this seems to indicate a lack of adequate reserve in either water or water pressure capacity.

The stench emanating from the sewage treatment plant while playing the Spruce and Links Golf Courses likewise seems to indicate a current problem with either the actual treatment or processing capacity of the plant.
