FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S MOTION TO DISMISS COMPLAINT

FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY ("FPL"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.037(2)(a), Florida Administrative Code, files this Motion to Dismiss GLAMOUR INDUSTRIES, INC.'s ("GLAMOUR") Complaint for lack of jurisdiction and states:

- GLAMOUR has filed a Complaint against FPL pursuant to Rule 25-22.036, Florida Administrative Code and has alleged in its Complaint that FPL breached a contract that expired in 1993 between the two companies.
- GLAMOUR also alleges in its Complaint that it was excluded from bidding on FPL projects.
- 3. According to Rule 25-22.036(5), F.A.C., "a complaint is appropriate when a person complains of an act or omission by a person subject to Commission jurisdiction which affects the complainant's substantial interests and which is in violation of a statute enforced by the Commission, or of any Commission rule or order."
- The Commission does not have jurisdiction over breach of contract actions. <u>Deltona</u>
 Corporation v. Mayo, 342 So. 2d 510 (Fla. 1977).
- Furthermore, there are no statutes, Commission rules or orders that dictate which contractors an investor owned utility must invite to bid for its work.
