Consistent with the Commission's decision, briefs are to be filed within 10 days of the <u>GTE</u> opinion becoming final. Because a petition for rehearing was not filed, the opinion became final March 15, 1996. Accordingly, please note that briefs should be filed by close of business on March 25, 1996.
