PURPOSE: The purpose of the workshop is to discuss what changes to Rules 25-6.022 and 25-6.052 through 6.058, F.A.C., if any, should be recommended to the Commission for proposal based on the 1995 version of the American National Standard Code for Electric Meters (ANSI standards). In addition, information will be gathered concerning whether the meter testing rules require modification to reflect current technology and industry practices. Finally, the current data retention requirements in Rule 25-6.022 will be addressed to determine whether the requirements should be changed. All interested persons should come prepared to discuss the above items.
