BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND RESPONSE TIME

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), and Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc. ("MFS") and pursuant to Rule 25-22.037, Florida Administrative Code, files a Joint Motion to Extend Response Time.

- 1. By Order No. PSC-96-0444-FOF-TP ("Order"), issued on March 29, 1996, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") required BellSouth and MFS to instigate and complete certain tasks within 60 days of the issuance of the Order.
- 2. BellSouth and MFS have worked diligently to complete the obligations in good faith since the issuance of the Order. Two of these obligations, however, are unable to be completed within the 60 day time frame given by the Commission.
- 3. First, BellSouth and MFS are attempting to develop a comprehensive proposal for sub-loop unbundling for the Commission's review as required by the Order. While BellSouth and MFS have met on several occasions to discuss this issue, it appears that a resolution will not be available in the time frame required by the Order. BellSouth and MFS, therefore, request an additional 30 days or until June 28, 1996 in which to complete

development of a mutually estisfactory plan for sub-loop unbundling.

4. Second, the Order requires Bellsouth to file cost studies for certain loops and ports requested by MFs. Bellsouth will have those studies completed within the time frame required by the Order, with the exception of the study for the four-wire analog port. BellSouth is working with MFS to complete this study. BellSouth, therefore, requests an additional 30 days or until June 28, 1996 in which to complete development of the cost study for the four wire analog port.

WHEREFORE, BellSouth and NFS respectfully request that the Commission extend the time in which BellSouth is to file the cost study for the four wire analog port and the proposal for sub-loop unbundling until June 28, 1998.
